Instructions for Submission

To submit your paper for consideration to the Special 2024 ThReD Conference @MIT SLOAN please take the following steps. You will need a free account with the Conference Maker. If you do not have an account, you may sign up for an account on the website

1. Go to the Conference Maker website:

https://editorialexpress.com/conference/MITThReD/

- 2. If you have a Conference Maker account, log in with your username and password. Otherwise, find the link at the bottom to create an account or retrieve login info.
- 3. Once you have logged into the Conference Maker page for the conference, you will see a toolbar labeled "Main Menu" on the left of the page. Click the first link under the "Papers" heading to "Submit a Paper."
- 4. Enter your paper information into the submission form, including the paper title and an abstract. Upload the PDF by selecting it or entering its exact URL. Please use a readable PDF format and refer to the provided guidelines. Please be sure to provide the exact URL of the paper itself so that the paper will be automatically uploaded into the Conference Maker system.
- 5. Under "Select committee member/area", you may have the option to select a particular member of the program committee. We'll try to honor your preference, but reassignment to other reviewers may occur.
- 6. Press "submit" to submit your paper for consideration. It may take a minute for everything to upload. You should receive e-mail confirmation that your submission was successfully received.
